Studio Affiliations: Leah Raidt is an Instructor and Private Coach at The Green Room Studio, Chicago and Actors Training Center in Wilmette, IL and is a working professional actor/producer. The following services and rates are in alignment with the private coaching rates at The Green Room Studio.

SERVICES & RATES

1 Hour Virtual Coaching: \$65 // 30 Minute Virtual Coaching: \$30

Personalized coaching and training via Zoom. While it is not a total replacement for getting to work in front of the camera in a professional space, it can help with script analysis, rehearsal, and self-tapes from home. You are welcome to share this time with others. For each additional student, I charge \$10.

IN STUDIO: Audition Taping: 1 Hour: \$85

Come to the studio and I will coach, tape, edit and compress your self-tape audition! We usually recommend about 40 to 45 minutes for coaching and taping, with 15 to 20 minutes for editing and uploading. Overtime for taping and/or editing is prorated.

Home studio is located in Uptown/Andersonville. Other studio options (with limited availability) is The Green Room Studio at 1915 W Chicago Ave and Actors Training Center in Wilmette, IL

1 Hour In-Studio Coaching : \$85

An hour of personalized coaching and training: This can be used to prepare for an audition, brush up on your technique, build a process, and up level your career. You are also welcome to share this time with others. For each additional student, I charge \$15. You can organize a group for a private two hour class if you'd like. I am always happy to try to connect you with other interested students for a group brush up lesson.

Monologue Service: \$35

Let me help you find a monologue for auditions and submissions. The monologue service includes a prep guide, and multiple monologues that are hand-picked to showcase you and support your goals. Expect around 1 week for turnaround, but always let me know if you are working on a tight deadline.

\$20 + Self-Tape Consulting and Critiques

Send us an audition or practice tape, and we will record ourselves watching the tape, breaking down the scene, and providing detailed feedback. This tool is not only helpful to the actor but also to whoever is helping them tape at home. Pricing varies on the length and number of scenes.
